

## FERRIBY VILLAGE SHOW RULES

1. That the Judges be chosen by the Committee and that their decision in all cases shall be final.
2. The Judges have the power to withhold any prize or prizes or other award if in their opinion exhibits are not of sufficient merit. No exhibitor shall be awarded more than one money prize in any one class, but may be awarded place cards and points.  
NO MORE THAN 2 PRIZES CAN BE AWARDED IF THERE ARE 3 OR LESS ENTRIES IN ANY ONE CLASS UNLESS THE JUDGES CONSIDER THE STANDARD OF ENTRIES **TO BE VERY HIGH.**
3. That all questions of dispute which do not come within the jurisdiction of the Judges shall be settled by the Show Manager.
4. That the Committee, together with the Officers, shall be responsible for the arranging of the classes. No exhibitor shall be allowed to accompany the Judges while they are making the awards.
5. COMPLETE ENTRY FORMS FOR THE SUMMER SHOW TOGETHER WITH REMITTANCE TO BE IN THE POSSESSION OF THE SHOW MANAGER NOT LATER THAN 8.00 pm ON THE FRIDAY PRECEDING THE RELEVANT SHOW DATE. ENTRY FORMS MAY BE HANDED IN AT THE POST OFFICE UP TO 5.00 pm ON THE FRIDAY PRECEDING THE RELEVANT SHOW DATE.
- 5a. LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED UP TO 10.00 am ON THE DAY OF THE SHOW AT THE SHOW MANAGER'S DISCRETION AT A CHARGE OF 20p.
6. That all exhibits be staged between **8.00 am and 10.45 am** on the day of the show. Members of the public must leave the hall no later than this time.
7. That all specimens **remain on exhibition until 5.00 pm** on the evening of the show, at which time the show closes.
8. That all exhibits must be the property of the exhibitor and unless otherwise stated in the schedule must have been grown, raised, produced or made by the exhibitor.
9. That any exhibitor has the option of lodging an objection before 3.00 pm to any exhibit, on payment of 20p which shall be returned if the objection is upheld.
10. If there is any doubt as to the bona-fides of any exhibit or exhibits the Show Manager reserves the right to disqualify such entry or entries.
11. Exhibitors to provide own containers for all classes.
12. Prize Money may be collected from the Show Office between 3 pm and 4pm. Any Prize Money not collected by 4.30pm will be forfeit for the benefit of the show.
13. Cups and Trophies will be presented at approximately 4 pm. Trophy winners may, if they wish, have their names and year engraved on trophies at their own expense.
14. Any exhibit remaining unclaimed after 5.15 pm will be sold by auction for the benefit of the Show unless the Secretary has been specifically instructed to the contrary.
15. Novice. Someone who has not won a first prize in that section at any show.
16. All precautions will be taken against loss or damage to exhibitors' property. The Committee cannot be held responsible for any loss or damage however caused.
